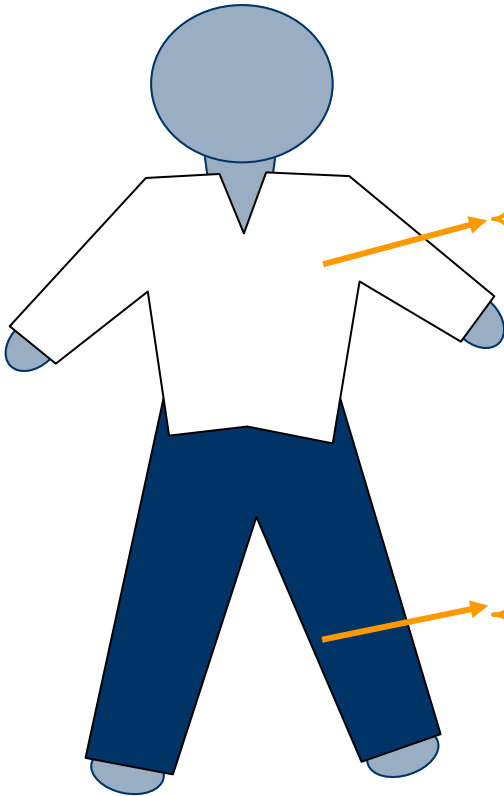




Blessed Sacrament School Dress Code



Beginning in September 2010, all students (JK to Grade 8) at Blessed Sacrament School will be expected to arrive at school dressed in the Appropriate Dress Code (details are outlined below). You may purchase clothing for your child at a retailer of your choice AND / OR you may purchase clothing from the school supplier, R.J. McCarthy Uniforms (rjmccarthy.com).



TOPS:

- Students are expected to wear a solid white or solid navy top
- You may send your child in any style top: polo shirt, blouse, turtle neck, collared shirt etc.
- Over clothing (such as sweaters or vests) should be solid navy
- No logos (except if you opt for the school crest)
- No extra colours at collar, stripes etc.

Tops that are not acceptable:

- Colours other than white or navy
- Tops with wording, pictures, stripes (other than the school crest)
- Tops with a brand name logo
- Midriff bearing tops & tank tops

BOTTOMS:

- Students are expected to wear navy blue bottoms (no denim)
- You may send your child in pants, skirt, skort, shorts, tunic
- No logos (except if you opt for the school crest)

Bottoms that are not acceptable:

- Excessively short shorts or skirts
- Denim / jeans

OVER and OUTER WEAR:

- On cooler days if children wish to wear a sweater, vest or sweatshirt, they should wear one that is solid navy blue with no extra colours (except if you opt for the school crest).

ACCESSORIES:

- Socks / Tights: students may wear either navy or white.
- Shoes: Please send your child in appropriate and safe shoes (ie: running shoes on gym day; flip flops are never safe at school).

For those interested in purchasing from R.J. McCarthy Uniforms, there will be an information table set up at the Fun Fair on May 8th, with samples of the clothing (no orders will be taken that day). There will be a fitting / order day at the school on June 2 from 4 - 7 pm (for surnames A-L) and June 3 from 4 - 7 pm (for surnames M-Z).

Crest must not exceed 3.5 X 3.5"

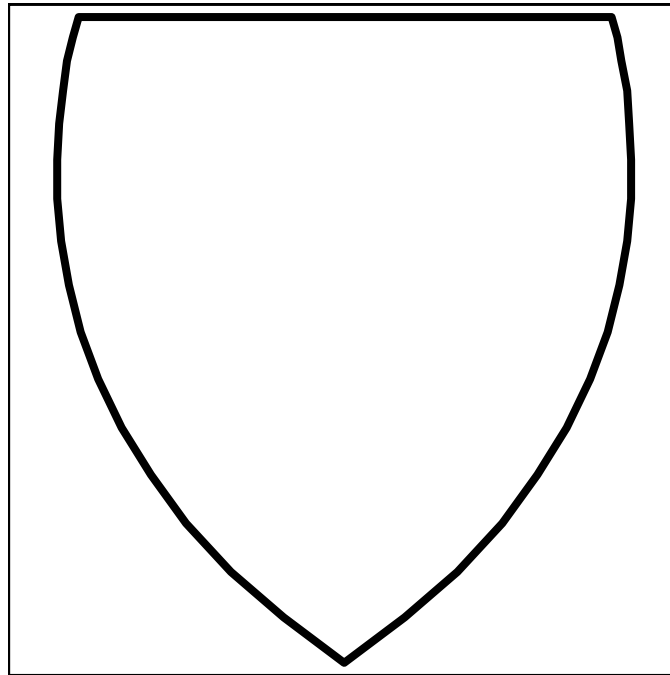
Keep ideas simple - intricate designs don't embroider well
